DEAR ALL,

This is part 6 of the GLORIA newsletter, to inform you about the news around the GLORIA trial. Recruitment progresses too slow. This is a major concern since we have to include 747 patients more patients in the coming 9 months (and now we included 53 in the past 9 months)... So we need 'all hands on deck' to fulfil our milestones!



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RECRUITMENT AND INCLUSIONS

At the moment, GLORIA is ready to include patients in 25 of the 30 sites. We would like to congratulate: Prof. Van Laar, prof. Boonen, Dr. Kok, Dr. Klaasen and Dr. Bos from the Netherlands, Prof. Da Silva and Dr. Micaelo from Portugal, Prof. Cutolo from Italy, and Dr. Opris from Romania included their first patient(s). Since we still need 747 patients to include, extensive attention for recruitment is needed. In the Netherlands, last three months we organized two investigator recruitment meetings: one face-to-face meeting and two telephone meetings. During these meetings, the following interesting points were discussed:

Inclusion criteria:

- > RA according 1987 criteria is also OK!
- ➤ DAS28≥3.2, NB no other disease activity criteria, so e.g. also patients without swollen joints can enter (but try to avoid fibromyalgia patients in remission)
- Age ≥ 65 years, birthday on date of inclusion is OK!

Exclusion criteria:

Change, stop or start of antirheumatics in the past 3 months.
HOWEVER, start or change of medication at baseline (right away after inclusion) is OK!
This includes giving an im or ia injection with glucocorticoids, as the protocol allows a total of 2 im injections and 4 ia injections in the 2-year study period.

Recruitment:

Attendees indicated that pre-screening the patients statuses is very useful. If this is done during for example the preparations of the visits for clinical care, than this is not that much work.

STUDY MEDICATION

- When using the pill bottle for the first time and you remove the sticker, please look carefully if the little red lamp beneath it is burning for 3 times. This indicates the bottle is activated.
- ➤ Please do not forget to enter the current RA medication EVERY visit into the eCRF, since RA medication is a very important outcome of the trial.

ECRF

- We know it is quite some work to enter all study data during the first visit. But please do not be discouraged, the follow-up visits are much less work.
- > When laboratory analyses have not yet been completed at the time of the GLORIA visit, you can tick these as missing in the eCRF. In that case, please open an unscheduled visit in the eCRF when the data is available for you to enter. Of course it is not a real visit, the patient need not be present for this.

TIPS & TRICKS

➤ GOOD CLINICAL PRACTICE:
